

**METHUEN CONSERVATION COMMISSION**  
**Minutes of Meeting – March 19, 2009**

The City of Methuen Conservation Commission held a public meeting on March 19, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. in the William Quinn Public Safety Building, Sanborn Hall. Present for this meeting were Suzanne M. Lamoureux, Chairperson, John Wilkens, Vice Chairperson, Christopher Parsons, Secretary, George Kazanjian, Financial Secretary, and Commissioner Sandra Boulay (arrived 7:05 p.m.). Also present was Joseph T. Giarrusso, Conservation Officer and Head Clerk, Dianne A. Dewan. Commissioner Isabel Tourkantonis was absent.

The Chairperson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
