

# Frequently asked questions:

Q: What are your office hours?

A: Monday thru Thursday: 7:00am - 4:30pm. Friday: Closed

Q: How do you get on the Fire Department?

A: You must take a Civil Service Test. For more information please contact the Human Resources Department at 978-983-8580.

Q: How do I get my home inspected for smoke and CO detectors because I am either selling or refinancing my home?

A: You must come to 24 Lowell Street to the Administrative Offices of The Methuen Fire Department (located in the rear of the building) and then schedule an appointment for the inspection. When you are here at the Office, a handout will be given to you explaining where these detectors are to be installed in your home. It is neither easy nor productive to try to explain these locations over the telephone. These inspections are done on Tuesday and Thursday mornings. There is a \$50.00 fee for this inspection. A check made out to the City of Methuen for this inspection would be greatly appreciated.
