

UPCOMING VETERANS MEMORIAL EVENTS



Saturday, May 1, 2010 at 9am to Noon

We will be edging the bronze markers on the veterans' graves at the Elmwood Cemetery on Rt. 113 in Methuen (on the way to Dracut). Please wear comfortable shoes and **bring an edger** to be able to remove the sod. You must bring your own tools. This is an annual event and it is usually the Methuen city-wide clean-up day. We will be meeting at the cemetery at 9:00 regardless if it is the city-wide clean-up. This is a great project!

Saturday, May 8, 2010 at 9am to 11:30am

We will be replacing the flags on the veterans' graves at the Walnut Grove Cemetery on Grove Street. Then we will be going over to the Elmwood Cemetery and the St. Anthony's Cemetery on Rt. 113. We are working with the Director of Veterans' Affairs for the city of Methuen, Tom Hargreaves. Flags are provided by the city for this effort.

Saturday, May 15, 2010 at 9am to 11:30am

We partner with the Director of Veterans' Affairs in both Lawrence (Francisco Urena) and Methuen, Tom Hargreaves. We are replacing the veterans' flags in St. Mary's Cemetery, Bellevue, and Immaculate Conception Cemeteries. We replace approximately 7000 flags that day. Flags are provided.
